- Registration with Volunteer Scotland is in progress.
- A Microsoft Form has been circulated to gather member details.
- Once registered, members will receive PVG application links.
- All members should complete the form; current membership stands at twelve.
- A training session on the new system will take place later this month.
- Reduce risk: volunteers should apply for school-based PVG to allow autumn events to proceed.
