Templates are available from the CONNECT website and the committee discussed the need to ensure wide consultation in the revision process and implementation for the next school year. Action: LF to bring a draft constitution document for discussion and agree process for review at next meeting</p> <p>Links to PTA would also be clarified in the constitution so that reporting and accountabilities are clear. East Dunbartonshire Vision and Strategy	LF updated the committee on the recent East Dunbartonshire Parent Council meeting (meeting for all Parent Council Chairs). This included the new Strategy (document circulated), communication and knowledge sharing between Chairs and the Education corporate services reporting. The committee discussed the vision and were supportive of the aims and objectives. The next meeting is on the 24 Feb.
Connect Membership	LF reminded the committee that Baljaffray Parent Council has joined Connect, a national body offering events, resources, and training for councils and PTAs. Provides access to PVG checks and public liability insurance. Mrs Logan and Mrs Wesley are driving this initiative. We have planted trees and saplings. We have arrange to have a no mow area in which we plan to plant wild flowers. We have ordered a polytunnel to grow veg and plants. We are expecting Willow trees to create Willow tunnel this week. We have been given pallets from Sainsburys and we have been using them to create planters. One of our grandparents has very kindly taken a number of pallets and has been creating outdoor mud kitchen • The Circle –work continues. We have been looking at classroom environments using the Circle Purpose to ensure consistent supports/ organisation in place in all classrooms. Also working on social environment to ensure interactions consistent and appropriate. <p>Staffing</p> <p>Additional teacher at P5 as numbers have gone above 33. At moment Miss Sutton Adamson but we have now interviewed successful candidate Shona Stadele.</p>

	Other Information National Thematic Inspection of Literacy and English - Summarised Findings very positive Proposed new branded PE kit (Schoolwear made easy) – which can be worn to school – tracksuit- prices were discussed with the Council. Consensus was this was a good idea for identity and inclusion, however costs of multiple kits would place a significant burden on parents. School to consider implications.
